Profile of Mr. D. Sivanandhan
Commissioner of Police, Mumbai

- Born and brought up in Coimbatore in Tamil Nadu
- Post-graduation in M.A (Economics)
- Joined Indian Police Service – Maharashtra Cadre in 1976
- From 1987-1993: Served six years in the Intelligence Bureau as Assistant Director and Deputy Director
- From 1993 to 1995: As the Additional Commissioner of Police, Crime Branch, Mumbai City
- From 1995 to 1998: As Deputy Inspector General of Police, Nagpur Range
- From 1998 to 2001: As Joint Commissioner of Police, Crime Branch, Mumbai
- From 2001 to 2004: As Joint Director C.B.I, Western Zone (Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Goa and Gujarat)
- From 2004 to 2005: As Commissioner of Police, Nagpur (as Addl. D.G.P)
- From 2005 to 2008: As Commissioner of Police, Thane
- From 2008 to 2009: As Commissioner S.I. D, Maharashtra State, Mumbai
- From June 14, 2009 onwards as the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai

Mr. D. Sivanandhan has acquired knowledge in almost all fields of policing – including City and Rural Policing, Mafia Crime control in Mumbai city.

With the I.B. he has garnered experience in Immigration, Foreign Registrations and Counter Espionage and Anti Corruption experience in the Central Bureau of Investigation (C.B.I) and anti Naxal Operations in the Nagpur region for three years.
